## **OCCUPATIONAL DRIVER'S LICENSE**

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR MAINTAINING YOUR OCCUPATIONAL DRIVER'S LICENSE

- 1. As part of the DWI/Drug Court Program, you are eligible to obtain an Occupational Driver's License (ODL) through our court. We will prepare the order for you once you provide us with a copy of your SR22 insurance form. Your SR 22 form can be obtained from your insurance provider. You may email the form to <a href="mailto:jchambers@co.collin.tx.us">jchambers@co.collin.tx.us</a> or fax the form to: (972) 548-3868. If your mailing address is different from the one on your driver's license, please let us know so we can change it on the ODL.
- 2. Once Judge Mason has signed the ODL, Ms. Chambers will contact you to pick it up from the Clerk's office. You need to pay \$14.00 cash or check so that the Clerk can mail a certified copy to the State of Texas and provide you with a certified copy to carry in your vehicle.
- 3. You must carry a certified copy of the ODL with you in your vehicle at all times and carry a log book, such as a spiral notebook, to log your driving time and mileage. Your driving time cannot exceed 12 hours per day in any 24 hour period.
- 4. The ODL is only good for approximately 30 days. You should receive a printed ODL from the State of Texas within 30 to 45 days. If not, you should contact DPS immediately.
- 5. DPS will also mail a laminated copy of the ODL a couple of weeks after that.
- 6. Pay close attention to all mail from DPS. Minimal fees can cause your license to go back into a suspended state. They will work with you on a payment plan for surcharges.
