Early Voting Begins June 6!

The cities of Plano and McKinney will be holding a runoff election on June 18th. Early Voting will begin June 6 and will run through June 14. Check the Collin County website for times & locations!



Redistricting Update

Redistricting efforts are still underway in the state legislature. Voting precincts may need to be adjusted to accommodate the new district boundaries.

Military Voting Bill

Side Effects

The legislature has passed Senate Bill 100, which moves the Primary Runoff Election date to the fourth Tuesday in May.

The bill keeps Texas in compliance with the MOVE Act, a federal law that went into effect in 2009. Among other things, the MOVE Act requires military and overseas ballots to be mailed 45 days before the election. With Texas' current primary runoff schedule, it was not possible to mail them out before the deadline.

The new runoff date impacts the ability of counties to conduct city and school elections in May. Some jurisdictions will move their elections to November, and some will conduct their own.
