



## March 2012 Election Outlook



### Elections 2012

Texas Redistricting is finished. New Voter Registration Cards will be mailed prior to the Democratic and Republican Primary. The date for the Primary has been set for May 29, 2012.

When you receive your new voter registration card, please take the time and make sure all the information is correct.

If you do not receive a voter registration certificate, it could be because you have moved. Voter registration certificates (unless you updated your information with our office) will be mailed to the address on your registration record. If you moved, these certificates are not forwarded but are returned to our office. At that point your voter registration is put in "Suspense" status. When you go to vote, there will be an "S" by your name and you will be required to fill out a "Statement of Residence" before being allowed to vote. If you do not receive your certificate call our office and we will help you with the process of updating your voter registration.

If you have moved from another county in Texas, you must register in the new county as voter registration does not transfer from county to county.

If you are not registered and want to vote in the important elections of 2012, Voter registration applications may be available at public libraries, post offices, Chambers of Commerce, banks and on line.

**5-17-12—Last day to register to vote in the 6-16-12, City/School Run off Election**

**7-2-12—Last day to register to vote in the 7-31-12, Primary Runoff Election**

**10-9-12—Last day to register to vote in the 11-6-12, Presidential Election**
