

This outage left the dispatch center without any administrative phone lines, TLETS nor CAD operating system. Patrick quickly notified all of the necessary personnel and vendors to report the outage. Not knowing if the 911 lines were effected as well, Patrick re-routed incoming 911 calls to our back up PSAP, Allen PD. Without the CAD system, Dispatch had to operate in a manual mode by taking call information by hand and dispatching all units using paper call notes. Patrick did a phenomenal job in making sure that dispatch operations continued to function normally and neither the citizens nor the units out in the field felt the effects of the outage.
