

POLICY
OFFICIAL TEXAS HISTORICAL MARKERS
Applications and Installation
Collin County, Texas

1. All state markers are the property of the Texas Historical Commission (THC) and not the landowner.
2. State markers in Collin County are shipped to Collin County Public Works, not to the owner of the site where the marker will be installed.
3. State markers are installed by Collin County Public Works a few days prior to the public Marker Unveiling and Dedication Ceremony.
4. Applications for state markers are only submitted to the THC by the Collin County Historical Commission (CCHC) when the site is ready for the marker to be installed.
5. When the land around the proposed site of a future marker is in transition, marker narratives may be submitted to the CCHC for review. The application for an Official Texas Historical Marker will not be submitted to the THC until after development is completed and there is public access to the site.
