Program Available to Collin County Residents



Guide and File, a web-based program powered by *Tyler Technologies*, is now available to Collin County residents. The program allows individuals to create certain legal forms for filing online using preformatted, step-by-step templates that will generate a completed form.

You can access the forms through **EFileTexas** from any computer. Registration is free and once you sign up, you can save your work and resume working on your document at your convenience from any location. The website has a tutorial and guides you through all of the information required for that particular form page-by-page.

Once a final document has been generated, customers will have the option of printing their form for handfiling or e-filing using a credit card.

Additional forms are being developed and will be added periodically, so users are encouraged to check back if the form they need is not yet listed.
