Resources for Legal Representation in Texas

Because the Collin County Probate Court is unable to recommend or refer attorneys in the area of probate, guardianship, or any other area of law, we have compiled this list of resources that may help applicants to locate an attorney or service who may be able to assist them with legal needs in our Court. Please note that this list has an emphasis on low-income representation and a maximum income threshold may be in place for representation.

General resources:

State Bar of Texas - Find a Lawyer

This tool hosted by the Texas State Bar Association allows users to set certain parameters and look up licensed attorneys in Texas. There is an option to alter fee options (including payment plans and sliding scale fees) that may be useful for finding low-income representation.

Collin County Bar Association Attorney Referral Directory

This resource contains a list of attorneys who serve the Collin County area and are experienced in practicing in Collin County.

Low-Income Resources:

Legal Aid of Northwest Texas

Legal Aid of NorthWest Texas works to ensure equal access to justice by providing free civil legal services to low-income individuals and families in 114 counties across North and West Texas.

Texas Law Help - Legal Event and Clinic Calendar

Texas Law Help hosts a calendar of events and clinics across the state. These clinics may help the user to locate a source of free or low-cost legal representation, advice, or direction.
