Mr. Kim,

At its regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, July 28, 2025, the Princeton City Council voted unanimously (6-0) to extend fire protection services to unincorporated areas of Collin County currently covered under the existing agreement between the City and the County. The extension will remain in effect **through November 30, 2025**.

The Council action was taken to ensure uninterrupted fire protection coverage for these residents while the creation of the Emergency Services District No. 1 (ESD-1) is considered on the November 4, 2025, ballot. If the measure is not approved, the City will request further dialogue with Collin County to determine a path forward regarding fire protection services beyond the extension period.

The City of Princeton remains committed to the safety and well-being of all communities served during this period of transition. Princeton Fire Department personnel will continue to respond to calls for service in these unincorporated areas with the same level of professionalism and reliability that residents have come to expect.
