TxDOT DRIVEWAY PERMITS

If your parcel is located in any one of the following city's ETJ (Extra Territorial Jurisdiction), and your (future) driveway is located on a TxDOT roadway (SH, US, FM, or SPUR) you must *contact that city* in order to apply for a TxDOT driveway permit.

Upon application to Collin County Development Services, for an On Site Sewage Facility (OSSF), Commercial or Development Permit, a letter from the city will be required stating that you have contacted them regarding the TxDOT driveway permit

You must also *contact the city* for the final TxDOT driveway permit approval.

If your parcel is located in any other City's ETJ (not listed above) or outside any city limits or ETJ, please *contact the TxDOT Collin County Area Office* to obtain a driveway permit.

Upon application to Collin County Development Services, for an On Site Sewage Facility (OSSF), Commercial or Development Permit, proof of the TxDOT driveway permit application will be required.
