2. Approval of June 6, 2025 Minutes

Steve made a motion to approve, second by Brian., which passed unanimously.

3. Update on Transportation Planning

Brendon Wheeler from NCTCOG gave a PowerPoint Presentation: Mobility 2025-The Metropolitan Transportation Plan for North Central Texas. Some of the takeaways were:

- Mobility 2050 was adopted in June 2025
- North Central Texas is heading to be the 3rd largest metropolitan area in US
- From 2026-2050 population is projected to increase by 70%
- Population will continue to grow and traffic congestion will continue to get worse. There are 3 public transportation authorities: DART, Trinity Metro and Denton Co Transportation Authority
- We have to have transit, but need to solve governance and funding.
- How can Planning Board help?
 - Talk to legislators, encouraging them to put priority on creating additional transit authorities where they do not exist now and to develop method of funding.
 - Encourage TXDOT to provide funds.
 - Encourage cities to incentivize high density development along rail transit system
