

1. Call Meeting to Order

Meeting was called to order at 6:07PM by Mark Quinn. The following members were present: Steve Terrell, Rick Cashen, Steven Wright, Mike Wallace, Mark Quinn, Doug Reece, Steve Matthews and Sammy Yang. The following members were not present: Matt Thomas, Brian Reinhardt, Rusty Glover, Kelle Berry and Bill Mills. Collin County staff present: Clarence Daugherty and Dawn Redwine Guests: Madeline Shepherd from Burns and MacDonnell

2. Approval of January 2, 2025 Minutes

Doug made a motion to approve, second by Steven W., which passed unanimously.

3. Presentation of the Southeast Mobility Study Final Report

Clarence gave a PowerPoint presentation. Some key points that were discussed:

PHASE 1-

- Background was given about leading up to the study from 2014-2015.
- In 2017 NCTCOG had to figure out another relief
- In 2018 they dropped it and the County picked it up
- Phase 1 was a public information effort to educate the public about the historical, current and future growth of the County and the impact it has on mobility – no presentation of specific projects.
- Phase 1 also provided status report on safety issues on roadways in the County (State, County and Cities)

PHASE 2-

- Thoroughfare Plan started in 1984
- Updated in 2014 and 2020 and new proposed update 2025
- Public meetings resulted in 450 comments from public input
- Comments and travel demand modeling were used to analyze the state of current mobility and projected future mobility
- A report with recommendations, as well as an updated Thoroughfare Plan, were the result of Phases 2
- Two additional public meetings were held specifically about the proposed revised Thoroughfare Plan and a Public Hearing will be held to finalize the revised Plan

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR FURTHER STUDY

- Alternative alignments for a southeast freeway and a northeast freeway were identified, but finalization of an alignment was recommended by further study

4. Discussion of Collin County ESD initiative

Mark gave a PowerPoint presentation. Some key points discussed:

- Funds are needed to provide fire service outside of cities – an Emergency Service District (ESD) can provide that funding with up to a tax of 10 cents/per \$100
- Public Hearing will be held -July 28
- An election will be held on November 4, 2025, to determine if an ESD will be created
