Significant Events for August 2010

- For the 11 months ended August 31, Health Care Original Budget was \$4.1M; the Adjusted Budget is \$5.4M. With 1 month remaining, Available Budget is \$1.4M, or 25.9% of Adjusted Budget.
- Cash and cash equivalents totaled \$1.6M at 08-31.
- The minimum required fund balance for the Health Care Foundation has dropped below the threshold to \$14,050,882. According to the 1983 agreement, the County paid \$14,858,382.31 to the Foundation for indigent health care. At August 31, the fund balance of the Foundation (on the accrual basis, which includes real estate) is at \$14,050,882, or \$807,500 below the threshold.

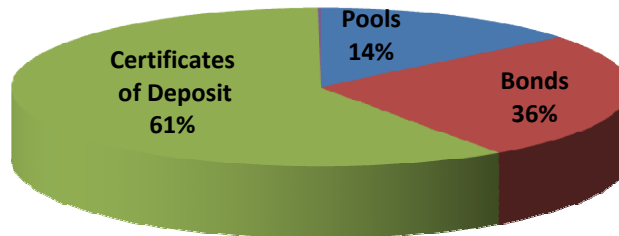
