On August 8, 2026, Officer Victoria Sanchez demonstrated exceptional attentiveness. Recognizing the importance of a request, Officer Sanchez immediately notified the Sergeant's Office and ensured the information was properly elevated through the chain of command. Her actions helped initiate an investigation and subsequent search of Pod 3A, during which Officer Sanchez located suspected controlled substances. This was removed from the facility before it could potentially be distributed among the inmate population. Officer Sanchez's actions during this incident reflect the professionalism, sound judgment, and attention to detail she consistently demonstrates in her duties.

As a Field Training Officer, she is also entrusted with preparing new officers to safely and effectively perform their responsibilities while modeling these same qualities. Her ability to recognize a potential threat, communicate appropriately, and take timely action contributed directly to the safety and security of fellow officers, detention staff, and inmates.
