Why the Honoree is receiving a GEM Award including dates:

In August 2024, Investigator Keith Griffin developed information regarding a fugitive and methamphetamine dealer operating in the western portion of Collin County. Investigator Griffin identified the subject and learned they had two outstanding felony warrants for Fraud and Manufacture/Delivery of a Controlled Substance Penalty Group 1. Over the course of a few weeks Investigator Griffin developed a plan of action and coordinated with unit supervisors and team members to establish surveillance and gather a pattern of life for the subject.

Once the Special Operations Unit had assets available and in place, Investigator Griffin orchestrated the purchase of methamphetamine from the subject with the objective to lure the subject out of their residence to ultimately meet with law enforcement for a controlled purchase of methamphetamine. A traffic stop resulted in the seizure of two ounces of methamphetamine and the apprehension of a wanted fugitive out of this county.

Investigator Griffin's commitment to his work and this team not only make him a valuable member of the Special Operations Team, it also makes him a notable recommendation for Employee of the Month.
