He consulted with Texas Board of Pardons and Paroles, who suggested implementing Zoom parole hearings to reduce the required visits.

Officer Denison worked with other JCOs and Deputy Doyle to implement this idea, obtaining additional tablets and collaborating with Texas Board of Pardons and Paroles to establish the necessary communication.

As a result, parole hearings are now conducted more efficiently, reducing non-supervised contact visits and allowing more effective communication between JCC staff and platoons regarding parole holds. Officer Denison's initiative and dedication to improving the parole process makes him an ideal Employee of the Month candidate.
