Honoree's Job Title: Dispatcher

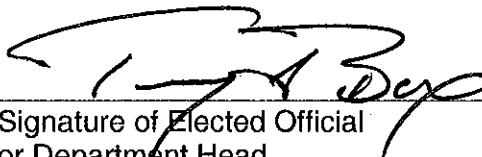
