

**JOINT ELECTION ORDER
LOVEJOY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT
BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

THE STATE OF TEXAS
COUNTY OF COLLIN

On this the 21st day of January 2020, the Board of Trustees of the Lovejoy Independent School District convened in Open Session, open to the public, with the following members present to-wit:

Chad Collins, Amy Smith, Anne Smith, Matt Gournay, Jennifer Kline, Barrett Owens

and the following absent:

Al Litchenburg

constituting a quorum and among other proceedings had by said Board of Trustees was the following:

WHEREAS, the term of office for Position 4, currently held by Anne Smith, Position 5, currently held by Matt Gournay, and Position 7 currently held by Barrett Owens of the Board of Trustees of Lovejoy ISD, will expire on the first Saturday in May 2020, said first Saturday being May 2, 2020, and on said date a Trustee Election will be held in said School District.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for this Board of Trustees to adopt an order establishing the procedure for filing and for conducting said Trustee Election.

WHEREAS, this Board finds it to be in the best interest of the voters of the District to contract with the Town of Fairview (the "Town") to conduct a joint election on May 2, 2020.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF LOVEJOY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

1. That a Trustee Election be held in said School District on May 2, 2020, for the purpose of electing to the Board of Trustees of said School District Position 4 and Position 5 members for full three-year terms and Position 7 member for a one-year term.

That all requests by candidates to have their names placed upon the ballot for the above mentioned election shall be in writing and signed by the candidate and filed with the Secretary of the Board of Trustees at the Superintendent's Office not later than February 14, 2020 at 5:00 PM.

2. The Trustee Election shall be administered by the Elections Administrator of Collin County (the "Contracting Officer") in accordance with the authority of Subchapter D, Section 31.091, Texas Election Code, and for the purposes of the administration of the Trustee Election, the Board authorizes the execution of an election services agreement for Election Services with the Contracting Officer (the "Election Services Agreement").

3. Early voting by personal appearance will be conducted each weekday at:

Applications for ballot by mail must be received no later than the close of business on the 11th day before Election Day.

5. The Trustee Election shall be held as a joint election with the Town of Fairview and this Board hereby authorizes the execution of one or more contracts for a joint election (the "Joint Election Agreement") with the Town of Fairview.
6. The Board of Trustees shall give notice of the Trustee Election.

The President of the Board of Trustees is hereby authorized and instructed to post or cause to have posted said Notice at three (3) public places where notices are customarily posted in this School District, and said posting shall be made not later than 21 days before the date of said election. The President shall also cause a copy of this Notice to be published one (1) time in a newspaper of general circulation in the county where this School District is located. Said publication shall not be more than 30 days nor less than 10 days before the date of said election.

7. The Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the Superintendent to sign the Contract and Joint Election Agreements on behalf of the district.

The above order being read, it was moved and seconded that the same does pass. Thereupon, the questions being called for, the following members of the Board of Trustees voted AYE:


