ANNUAL DATA REPORT, FINDINGS AND ACTION PLAN April 2021

1. Reference: 28 CFR 115.388 – Data Review for Corrective Action
2. The sexual abuse and sexual harassment incident data has been reviewed and the Sexual Abuse and Sexual Harassment Aggregate Data report has been updated for the calendar year 2020
3. The following was noted for the calendar year 2020 data:
 - a. There were no (0) Youth-on-Youth Nonconsensual Sexual Acts reported.
 - b. Collin County Juvenile Detention reported two (2) Youth-on-Youth Abusive Sexual Contact incidents.
 - i. Both incidents were investigated.
 - ii. One (1) incident was Substantiated, with the other being Unfounded.
 - iii. The Substantiated incident was worked through with the facility's LSOTP, with steps taken to keep involved juveniles separate, further counseling, and new rules for the dayroom area.
 - c. Collin County Juvenile Detention reported fifteen (15) Youth-on-Youth Sexual Harassment incidents.
 - i. All incidents were investigated.
 - ii. Five (5) incidents were Substantiated.
 - iii. Eight (8) incidents were Unsubstantiated.
 - iv. Two (2) incidents were Unfounded.
 - d. Collin County Juvenile Detention reported one (1) incident of staff Sexual Misconduct.
 - i. The investigation was concluded as Unfounded by this facility, as well as TJJJ investigators.
 - e. Collin County Juvenile Detention reported one (1) incident of staff Sexual Harassment.

i. The investigation was concluded as Unsubstantiated by this facility through interview and video review.

f. Collin County Juvenile Detention reported two (2) incidents of reports made by a juvenile of abuse in an outside agency. These incidents were reported appropriately by this facility according to PREA guidelines.

4. CORRECTIVE ACTION: Video and interviews were conducted for all appropriate incidents. When appropriate, the investigation is overturned to TJJD. This facility strives to keep anyone involved in these investigations separate, and new policies and rules in the facility are enacted when appropriate.

5. Progress in the Prevention of, Detection of, and Response of Sexual Abuse and Harassment:

- a. The facility continues to train new officers on PREA standards, and review PREA standards with all officers annually.
- b. The PREA Coordinator, Superintendent, and Assistant Superintendent, along with supervisors, will continue to do unannounced rounds at unexpected times. The unannounced rounds will continue to happen across all shifts.
- c. The facility will investigate all allegations of sexual abuse/sexual harassment.
