

Information You Will Need to Complete the Protective Order Forms

In addition to the Application for Protective Order, Ex-Parte Protective Order and Protective Order, you will need to complete the Texas Crime Information Center (TCIC) Data Entry Form that provides vital information regarding the Protected Person(s) and the Respondent to law enforcement officials.

The Respondent is the party from whom you are seeking protection. Information needed for the Respondent will include:

- Name
- Current Address
- Sex
- Race/Ethnicity
- Date of Birth
- Social Security Number
- Driver's License Number
- Physical Description (i.e. eye and hair color, height, weight)

The Applicant is the party seeking protection. Information needed for the Applicant will include:

- Name
- Current Address
- Sex
- Race/Ethnicity
- Date of Birth
- Social Security Number
- Place of Employment Name and Address

If the Applicant is also seeking to protect children from the Respondent, the Applicant will need to include the following information regarding the children:

- Name of the Protected Child(ren)
- Sex
- Race/Ethnicity
- Date of Birth
- Child Care or School Facility Name and Address

If the Respondent does not know where you or the protected children live, work, or go to school, you may need to file a Confidential Protective Order. You can ask about the Confidential Protective Order at the Law Library.
